

Transportation to Portland State University

Airport Arrival

Free transportation to Portland State University: Friends of Overseas Citizens and University Students (FOCUS) can provide you with a free ride to PSU from the airport. You must email FOCUS to request this free service at focushomestays@yahoo.com.

Public transportation An alternative option is to take public transportation from the airport to downtown Portland. The MAX Red Line light rail service runs from the airport through downtown Portland every 15 minutes. A one-way trip from the airport to downtown Portland takes about 40 minutes and costs \$2.00. The MAX Red Line makes 10 stops downtown and provides convenient access to area hotels. You can purchase tickets from automated ticket machines located in the airport lobby near the baggage claim area as well as on the MAX station platform. To get to the PSU campus, take the MAX Red Line to the Rose Quarter Max Station (approximately 30 minutes). Get off the Max, and walk to the bus stop across the street. Take the Number 8 (NE 15th Ave to Portland) for approximately 15 minutes and ask the bus driver to let you off at the Broadway & Montgomery stop at PSU. For more information – go to www.trimet.org.

Taxi cab transportation A third option is to take a taxi. This is the fastest option, but also the most expensive option. Taxis are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week at the airport. A one-way trip to Portland State will cost \$35 - \$40 and will last approximately 20 – 40 minutes.
